BEET ROOT – REMO

F1 HYBRID



Maturity (from sowing)	: 60–65 days
Use Segments	: Topped, bunched, processing & pigment extraction
Bolt Resistance	: Late bolting habit
Adaptability	: Excellent drought tolerance and uniform growth
Yield	: Very high yield with an exceptional percentage of 1st grade roots

Foliage Characteristics

Top Height	: 30–33 cm
Leaf Habit	: Fully erect
Leaf Color	: Bright green with slight red tint

Root Characteristics

Shape	: Top-shaped
Internal Color	: Dark red
Sugar Content	: High Brix (12–15%)
Zoning	: Little to none (very uniform)

Disease Tolerance

Highly Tolerant	: Cercospora Leaf Spot
Moderately Tolerant	: Downy Mildew, Powdery Mildew
Tolerant	: Rhizoctonia



BEET ROOT – SUPER FAST F1 HYBRID



Leaf Color	:	Green with pink midrib
Root Shape	:	Round and uniform
Taproot	:	Very small
Root Color	:	Crimson red
Root Weight	:	190–200 gm
Maturity	:	50–55 days after sowing
Recommended Use	:	Fresh market, long-distance shipping, and storage

BEET ROOT – BYRAVA F1 HYBRID



Early Maturity	:	60–65 day
Top height	:	30 – 33 cm
Leaf habit	:	Fully erect
Leaf colour	:	Bright green with slight red tint
Root shape	:	flattish round
Root colour	:	Deep red
Disease tolerance	:	Tolerant to Anthracnose and leaf spot
		High yield and good adaptability

BEET ROOT – RED MAN IMPORTED



Plant Vigor	:	Vigorous with dark green, broad leaves and pink midrib
Root Characteristics	:	Slightly oblong-round shape with smooth, small taproot
Root Weight	:	200–210 gm
Adaptability	:	Excellent for summer season cultivation
Maturity	:	65 – 70 days
Suitability	:	Ideal for long-distance transport and fresh market

BEET ROOT – RUBY QUEEN IMPORTED



Plant Vigor	:	Vigorous with dark green, broad leaves and pink midrib
Root Characteristics	:	Slightly oblong-round shape with smooth, small taproot
Average Root Weight	:	190–200 grams
Adaptability	:	Well-suited for summer season cultivation
Suitability	:	Ideal for long-distance transport and fresh market
