

## PAK CHOI



- Plant type vegetable : Compact, upright, and fast-growing leafy
- Leaves : Smooth, tender, and dark green with glossy appearance
- Petiole (stalk) : Thick, broad, and white or pale green; crisp and juicy
- Maturity : Ready for harvest in 30-40 days after sowing
- Flavor : Mild, sweet, and slightly mustard-like taste
- Adaptability : Grows well in cool and mild climates; suitable for open field and greenhouse cultivation

## SQUASH - BOND-2

### F1 HYBRID



- Attractive light-green fruits with subtle flecking
- Very productive plant
- Flat blossom end, so harvested fruit sits upright
- Longer stem and open habit makes for easy harvesting
- Harvest at 2-3" diameter for best flavor
- Intermediate resistance to powdery mildew

## ZUCCHINI (SQUASH) - GREEN STAR

### F1 HYBRID



- Plant type : Bushy, compact, and erect with an open growing habit.
- Fruits : Shiny green, long cylindrical shape.
- Fruit size : Length 20-25 cm, diameter 4-5 cm.
- Fruit weight : 350-400 g
- Maturity : Begins 50-55 days after transplanting
- Special features : Uniform fruit shape, attractive glossy skin, and suitable for fresh market and long-distance transport

## ZUCCHINI (SQUASH) - YELLOW STAR

### F1 HYBRID



- Plant type habit : Bushy and compact with an open growing
- Fruits : Shiny golden-yellow, long cylindrical shape
- Fruit size : Average length 20-25 cm
- Productivity setting : Very high yielding with consistent fruit
- Maturity : Begins 50-55 days after sowing (DAS)
- Special features : Attractive glossy fruits, excellent market appeal, and suitable for fresh market and table use
